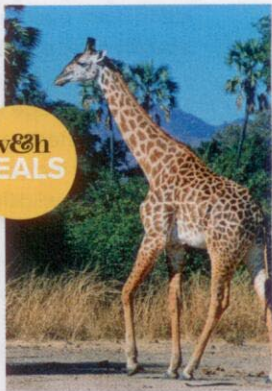


# 6 GO ON SAFARI

Tracking lions on foot through the African bush is as thrilling as a wildlife holiday gets. Zambia's South Luangwa National Park, the home of the walking safari, is where to do it.

Guides have an outstanding ability to follow both sounds and tracks to lead you – heart pounding – towards sun-basking baboons or a leopard lounging in a tree. Stay at Chinzombo, a contemporary-colonial lodge that has quickly established itself as one of the most luxurious in Africa. Its villas on the Luangwa River are so relaxing that visitors have been known to sacrifice a
